Anesthesiology, Intensive Care & Emergency Medicine year classe 3-5 taking place in Surgical Theatre NSSU (The New Location of the University Hospital in Kraków-Prokocim) on Jakubowski Street 2.

Travel is best by tram nr 3, 9, 12 or bus nr 133, 143, 144, 163, 173, 183, 204, 224, 244, 274, 301, 304, 314 or 503 – bus/tram stop "Prokocim Szpital". It is possible to access the Hospital directly by buses 143, 183 and 314 – bus stop "Instytut Pediatrii". Notice the hospital is about a 10 minute walk from the bus/tram stop "Prokocim Szpital".

Classes will be held in Surgical Theatre (wing F, floor +2). The easiest way to access the ward is by entering the Hospital via Entrance nr 2 (showed below), near the Emergency Room (SOR).





Next, walk forward along the corridor. Before reaching the next door, on your right you will find the elevator. Take it to the +3 floor, exit the lift and turn to the corridor on your left. There, you will find the entrance to the Operating Theatre.

Classes in the Operating Theatre will be held between 7.45 and 10.00 am. Good luck!
